This Cookie Policy explains how Bluewave Labs Limited (“Bluewave”, “we”, “us”, “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on the Bluewave Protocol website, ecosystem, applications, APIs, and Telegram Mini-App (“Platform”). This Policy forms part of our Privacy Policy available at <http://bluewaveprotocol.xyz/privacy>.

By accessing or using the Platform, you acknowledge and agree to the use of cookies and related technologies in accordance with this Policy and applicable law.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you access websites or applications.

Cookies help:

- enable functionality;
- improve performance;
- remember settings;
- enhance security; and
- support analytics.

Bluewave may also use:

- local storage;
- session storage;
- pixels;
- SDKs; and
- similar technologies,

which are collectively referred to in this Policy as “cookies.”

2. CONSENT & COOKIE CONTROLS

You will be presented with a cookie banner on your first visit to accept or reject non-essential cookies. You can change your preferences anytime via the “Cookie Settings” link in the footer of the website.

Note: The Telegram Mini-App does not set browser cookies. Only local storage is used within Telegram’s environment.

3. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

Type	Purpose	Duration
Strictly Necessary	Essential for Platform functionality, authentication, load balancing, and security	Session or up to 12 months
Functional	Stores preferences, language, themes, and usability settings	Up to 12 months

Analytics & Performance	Measures usage patterns, traffic, and feature performance	Up to 24 months
Security	Detects fraud, abuse, unauthorized access, and automated attacks	Session or up to 12 months
Third-Party	Used by integrated services such as Telegram, wallets, and analytics providers	Varies by provider

Bluewave does not use advertising or behavioural cross-site tracking cookies.

4. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

The Platform may integrate with third-party providers that set their own cookies, including:

- Telegram Mini-App SDK; For authentication and in-app functionality
- wallet providers; Meta Mask, Wallet Connect, and others for connection state
- analytics services; To understand usage patterns and improve performance
- and infrastructure providers.

These providers maintain independent privacy and cookie practices. Bluewave does not control third-party cookies or third-party processing activities. Users are encouraged to review third-party privacy policies separately.

5. LEGAL BASIS FOR USING COOKIES

Under the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023:

- Strictly necessary cookies may be processed under legitimate interest where necessary to operate and secure the Platform.
- Functional, analytics, and certain security-related cookies may be processed based on user consent where required by applicable law.
- Third-party cookies remain subject to the lawful bases and policies of the relevant third-party providers.

6. HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES

Users may manage cookies through browser or device settings. Most browsers allow users to:

- block cookies;
- delete cookies;
- restrict cookies; or
- receive cookie notifications.

Analytics cookies may also be controlled through opt-out tools or browser extensions where available. Telegram Mini-App cookie preferences may additionally be influenced by Telegram settings and third-party integrations. Disabling certain cookies may affect Platform functionality or performance.

7. DATA RETENTION

Cookies are retained for the durations specified in Section 2 unless deleted earlier by the user. Session cookies are generally deleted upon browser closure. Persistent cookies remain until expiration or manual deletion.

8. UPDATES TO THIS POLICY

Bluewave may modify this Cookie Policy periodically to reflect:

- technological developments;
- legal requirements;
- operational changes; or
- ecosystem updates.

Material changes shall be reflected by updating the “Last Updated” date. Continued use of the Platform following updates constitutes acknowledgment of the revised Policy.

QUICK FAQ

Q: Does Bluewave use cookies to track users across unrelated websites?

No. Bluewave does not use behavioural advertising or cross-site tracking cookies.
