Bluewave Labs Limited (“Bluewave”, “we”, “us”, “our”) operates the Bluewave Protocol website, ecosystem, services, applications, tools, APIs, and Telegram Mini-App (“Platform”).

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, disclose, and protect your personal data in compliance with the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023 (“NDPA”) and applicable regulations.

By accessing or using the Platform, you acknowledge and agree that your personal data may be processed in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable law.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

2. PERSONAL DATA WE COLLECT

We collect only data reasonably necessary to operate, maintain, improve, and secure the Platform.

A. Data You Provide Directly

This may include:

- wallet addresses;
- Telegram usernames and IDs;
- email addresses where voluntarily submitted;
- messages, support requests, and feedback;
- KYC/AML information where required, including:
 - full name,
 - government-issued identification,
 - proof of address,
 - selfies or verification photographs.

B. Data Collected Automatically

This may include:

- IP addresses;
- device identifiers;
- browser type;
- operating system;
- access logs;
- timestamps;

- usage activity;
- analytics information;
- cookies and tracking technologies; and
- publicly visible blockchain transaction data.

C. Data Obtained from Third Parties

We may receive data from:

- analytics providers;
- wallet providers;
- Telegram APIs and integrations;
- sanctions databases;
- fraud-prevention providers; and
- compliance verification services.

Bluewave does not knowingly collect special category data as defined under the NDPA unless legally required or voluntarily provided for compliance purposes.

3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

We process personal data for purposes including:

- operating and maintaining the Platform;
- enabling ecosystem participation;
- processing wallet interactions;
- verifying identity;
- fraud prevention;
- AML/KYC compliance;
- improving performance and analytics;
- communicating updates and support responses;
- ensuring system security;
- investigating misuse or abuse;
- complying with legal obligations; and
- enforcing our Terms and Conditions.

4. LAWFUL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

Under the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023, we rely on the following lawful bases:

Consent

Where users voluntarily provide consent, including:

- cookies;
- optional marketing communications; or
- optional feature participation.

Contractual Necessity

Where processing is necessary to provide Platform services or fulfil obligations under the Terms and Conditions.

Legal Obligation

Where processing is necessary to comply with:

- AML/KYC obligations;
- regulatory requests;
- court orders;
- tax requirements; or
- applicable legal obligations.

Legitimate Interest

Where reasonably necessary for:

- fraud prevention;
- platform security;
- ecosystem integrity;
- operational analytics; and
- improving Platform functionality.

5. DATA SHARING & DISCLOSURE

Bluewave does not sell personal data.

We may disclose personal data to:

Service Providers

Including:

- hosting providers;
- cloud infrastructure providers;
- analytics services;
- KYC/AML vendors; and
- technical contractors,

subject to confidentiality obligations.

Legal Authorities

Where disclosure is required:

- by law;
- court order;
- subpoena;
- regulatory directive; or
- compliance obligations.

Business Transfers

In connection with:

- mergers;
- acquisitions;
- restructurings;
- investments; or
- asset transfers.

Affiliates & Advisors

Where reasonably necessary for operational, legal, compliance, or administrative support.

6. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

The Platform may process or store personal data outside Nigeria. Where international transfers occur, Bluewave shall implement appropriate safeguards, including:

- standard contractual clauses;
- approved transfer mechanisms;
- adequacy decisions; or
- other protections recognized under applicable law.

7. DATA RETENTION

We retain personal data only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Policy or as required by law.

Retention periods may include:

Data Type	Retention Period
Account & Platform Data	Duration of account activity + 5 years
KYC/AML Data	5 years after relationship termination
Security Logs	Up to 12 months
Analytics Data	As reasonably necessary for Platform improvement

Certain blockchain-related data may remain permanently accessible on public blockchain networks and cannot be deleted by Bluewave.

8. YOUR RIGHTS UNDER NDPA

Subject to applicable law, users may exercise the following rights:

- Right of Access;
- Right to Rectification;
- Right to Erasure;
- Right to Restrict Processing;
- Right to Object;
- Right to Data Portability;
- Right to Withdraw Consent; and
- Right to Lodge Complaints.

Bluewave shall respond within applicable legal timelines.

9. COOKIES & TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

The Platform uses cookies and similar technologies for:

- functionality;
- analytics;
- fraud prevention;
- security;
- performance optimization; and
- remembering user preferences.

Users may disable cookies through browser settings, though certain Platform features may not function correctly.

Further information is available in our Cookie Policy.

10. DATA SECURITY

Bluewave implements reasonable technical, organizational, and administrative safeguards designed to protect personal data against:

- unauthorized access;
- misuse;
- disclosure;
- alteration; and
- destruction.

Security measures may include:

- encryption;
- access controls;
- authentication systems;
- monitoring tools; and
- secure infrastructure practices.

However, no digital system is completely secure. Users remain solely responsible for:

- safeguarding private keys;
- securing wallets;
- protecting credentials; and
- maintaining account confidentiality.

Bluewave shall not be liable for losses resulting from compromised wallets or user security failures. Where required by applicable law, Bluewave shall notify affected individuals and relevant regulatory authorities of qualifying personal data breaches within the timelines prescribed by law.

11. BLOCKCHAIN TRANSPARENCY NOTICE

Blockchain transactions may be publicly visible, traceable, immutable, and irreversible. Users acknowledge that certain wallet interactions and blockchain activity may remain permanently

accessible on public distributed ledgers. Bluewave cannot alter or delete public blockchain records.

12. MINORS

The Platform is not intended for individuals under eighteen (18) years of age. Bluewave does not knowingly collect personal data from minors. If we become aware that data belonging to a minor has been collected, reasonable steps shall be taken to delete such data.

13. THIRD-PARTY LINKS & SERVICES

The Platform may contain links or integrations relating to third-party services including:

- Telegram;
- wallet providers;
- analytics platforms;
- blockchain infrastructure; and
- external applications.

Bluewave does not control and is not responsible for third-party privacy practices or services. Users should review third-party policies independently.

14. CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

Bluewave may modify or update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect:

- legal changes;
- regulatory requirements;
- operational updates;
- technical developments; or
- ecosystem changes.

Material changes shall be reflected by updating the “Last Updated” date. Continued use of the Platform following updates constitutes acknowledgment of the revised Policy.
